Study of the language of literature, makes use of various tools of linguistic analysis. Theories and techniques of analysis. Corpus resources. The works of Leech and Short.

Theme 40. The analysis and examples of comparative method

Examine the graphetic level and structure of the comparative method analysis. The English judgements. Capitalization. Lexical (semantic) level. Morphological and syntactical level. Discourse and textual level.

Theme 41. The Quantitative method in Stylistics and definitions of style

Trace the quantitative or statistical aspects of stylistics. The notions of norm. The aim of quantitative stylistics. Categorical and deterministic statements. Statistical and probabilistic statements.

Theme 42. The effectiveness of teaching quantitative stylistic analysis to students

Looking through the most important stylistic analysis, such as qualitative and quantitative. Inter-textually. Intra-textually. Ambiguity. Ellipsis. Incomplete sentences.

Analyze categories of metaphor, including metonymy and synecdoche. Usage of metonymy and synecdoche in poetry. A simile.

Theme 47. Sarcasm. Paradox. Tautology.

Trace the development of sarcasm, paradox and tautology. Importance of sarcasm, paradox and tautology in stylistics.

Theme 48. Standard and non-standard language

Study of the concepts standard and non-standard language. Varieties of language. Factors of varieties language. Dialect and Register.

Theme 49. Compositional Patterns of Syntactical Arrangement

Structural syntactical stylistic devices. Syntactical expressive means of the language. Stylistic Inversion. Detached Construction. Parenthesis.

Theme 50. Language of the Drama

Study the definition of language and text in drama. Language features of drama. The stylization of colloquial language. "The Taming of the Shrew" and "Twelfth Night" by Shakespeare.

Theme 51. Stylistics as the linking component between linguistics and literary criticism

Analyze the difference between stylistic linguistics and literary criticism. A discipline. Multimodal stylistics and mediated stylistics.

Theme 52. Repetition. Enumeration.

Distinguish between the stylistic devices of repetition, enumeration and suspense. Anaphora. Epiphora. Catch repetition. Framing repetition. Types of enumeration.

Theme 53. Connection of Stylistics with Other Branches of Linguistics

Analyze the branches of linguistics and its linkage with other subjects. Phonostylistics. Lexicological Stylistics. Graphical Stylistics. Morphological Stylistics. Syntactic Stylistics.
